**AGES:** Boys ages 5 through 18 as of **April 30, 2008**. Girls ages 5 through 19 as of **December 31, 2007**. Proof of age is required at registration. A parent or guardian for players under 18 and those players 18 years of age or older must attend registration to sign forms giving permission to play and acknowledging player's assumption of the risks involved in the sport.

**FEES:** Senior Baseball \$105.00\*  
\*\*\$30.00 discount with coupon for those that register by 3/10/08 (only applies to Boys Senior Baseball)  
Buddy Ball \$20.00  
All Other Leagues (Tee-Ball, Bantam, Junior, Minor, Major, Pony & Girls' Senior) \$45.00.  
Each additional child in same family \$25.00/child

Non-Resident fee for those not residing in Millcreek Township \$10.00 per child

Players in leagues will, at registration, purchase five raffle tickets (for \$25) to then be sold, in addition to registration fees. Players may then keep funds received on their sale of tickets, but must return the stubs to MYAA by June 18, 2008. There will be a maximum of 2 ticket packs per family.

For purposes of first player fee, the highest fee due will be charged; the fee for each additional child is \$25. Where ticket limit applies to a family, the oldest two players will be assigned the tickets for return purposes.

Fees include the family membership/registration fee. The players will keep their tee-shirt jerseys and hats. You must purchase the child's pants. Dick's Sporting Goods is MYAA's preferred vendor. Pants must be **gray** in color for boys. Cash penalties apply to non-returned baseball equipment.

**PAYMENT:** **All fees must be paid in full at registration.** MYAA will accept payment of fees by cash or personal check (payable to "MYAA"). A \$10 return fee shall be charged to all checks returned to MYAA for any reason, plus fees due. No player is eligible to play in a program until all fees due are paid.

**REFUNDS:** There is **NO** refund of fees when a player registers and later decides to quit or play in another program. (This policy applies **after** May 1st)

**LATE REGISTRATION:** Late registration will be held at the MYAA Building, 2614 Colonial Avenue, on Monday, March 10<sup>th</sup> from 7-9 p.m. A late registration fee of \$5 per family, plus regular fees is charged. There is no guarantee that players attempting to register after March 10<sup>th</sup> will be placed on a team.

**TRYOUTS:** Tryouts and skill evaluations will be held in certain leagues, beginning in April. Dates and details will be provided at registration. Please be sure to pick up information forms at the league tables. All players new to a league must attend tryouts or skill evaluations. Anyone unable to attend must be excused by the league president prior to tryouts or will be placed on the league's reserve list.

**FUNDRAISER:** The MYAA Cash Raffle is now the fundraising event for all players in all programs. 50-50 game raffles will be conducted at all leagues' games. Fundraising is essential to success of MYAA programs and to keeping the fees for participation low. All players are required to participate in assigned fundraising activities. Those failing to participate are disciplined by being benched for one game. A small investment of everyone's time produces real benefits to all that play in MYAA leagues.
